

A QUICK GUIDE TO SKUNK ODOR REMOVAL

STEP 1: STAY CALM AND ACT QUICKLY

The faster you treat the skunk spray, the better your chances of eliminating the odor.

STEP 2: KEEP YOUR DOG OUTSIDE

Skunk spray is oily and pungent, you don't want it inside your house! Keep your dog outside while you gather supplies.

STEP 3: MIX THIS SKUNK ODOR REMOVAL REMEDY:

In a bucket, combine:

1 quart (4 cups) of 3% hydrogen peroxide

¼ cup of baking soda

1 - 2 teaspoons of liquid dish soap (like Dawn)

⚠ Do NOT store this mixture! It can build pressure and may explode in a closed container.

STEP 4: APPLY THE SOLUTION

Wear gloves and avoid getting the mixture in your pet's eyes, mouth, or ears.

Thoroughly massage the solution into your dog's dry coat.

Let it sit for 5 minutes, but not longer (peroxide can bleach fur).

Rinse completely with warm water.

Repeat if needed.

STEP 5: FOLLOW UP WITH A BATH

Once the smell is reduced, bathe your dog with their regular pet shampoo.

WHEN TO SEE A VET:

- If your pet was sprayed in the eyes, nose, or mouth
- If your pet is vomiting or acting lethargic
- If a skunk bite or scratch is suspected
